Topic: Given the increased rates of mental health challenges, first-year college students can be particularly vulnerable to a host of psychiatric disorders. For some Clinical Mental Health Counselors, it can be difficult to differentiate first-year clients who are experiencing distress due to difficulty managing life independently versus clients who are exhibiting early signs of psychiatric conditions. For clients in either category, effective strategies are needed to facilitate a healthy and integrated transition. This presentation provides information on the current state of mental health among college students and tools for counselors to promote "mental and emotional toughness" and a healthy transition to college.
